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Course information

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and clients' homes, who provide training and support in manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing. Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team. A Victorian Police check is required within this industry. In order to undertake your practical placement and secure employment in the future you are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check card. If you have any concerns please speak to our friendly staff.

Direct pathway from this qualification is Certificate IV in Ageing Support and Certificate IV in Leisure and Health.

Fees and Charges
