Entry to this course is open to individuals who have completed CHC30121 or CHC30113 - Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care. Students are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check to complete this course.

A pathway from this qualification is completing a Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood/Primary).
