COURSE INFORMATION

This course reflects the role of workers who provide services to clients in relation to mental health issues. They can provide psychosocial support, referral, advocacy, and education/health promotion services. These workers are required to have high level specialist knowledge, skills, and competencies especially regarding laws affecting people with mental health issues, the range of services available to them and health issues related to mental health.

PRE-REQUISITES

Students are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check to complete this course.

PATHWAYS

Direct pathways from this qualification are Community Rehabilitation and Welfare / Mental Health Support Workers.
